What is worth seeing in Bielsko-Biała

Szyndzielnia is a peak in the Silesian Beskids (1,028 m above sea level), rising north of Klimczok, located between the Olszówka, Wapienica and Białka valleys within the administrative boundaries of the city of Bielsko-Biała.

The location of Szyndzielnia encourages its residents and visitors to practice hiking, Nordic walking and mountain biking, but also to walk in the lower parts of the massif.

The 1,810 m long cable car leads to the peak. The ride in the yellow, glass gondolas provides an unforgettable experience. The wagons climb steeply to Szyndzielnia, at the beginning of the route squeezing between the peak of Kołowrot and the hills of Dębowiec and Cuberniok. While driving, we can constantly admire the beautiful panorama of Bielsko-Biała.

TRAIN STATION

The building of the Bielsko-Biała Główna railway station was built in 1890, beautifully restored and impresses with Pompeian polychromes in the main hall. In 1855, Bielsko received a connection with the Emperor Ferdinand Northern Railway, running from Vienna to Lviv.



POLISH THEATER BUILDING



The building of the Polish Theater (1890) at ul. 1 Maja 1 - in the style of Palladian-classicizing historicism, with Apollo and the muses Melpomene and Talia on the facade. Beautifully restored, richly decorated interior. The antique curtain depicts the dancing of nymphs. A fountain from 1895 in front of the theater. In the former painting room at the back of the building - a modern Small Stage.
